Writing	 ★ Write Ms. Gresham a letter or postcard. Math	 ★ Practice your BASIC FACTS every week. Addition and subtraction facts should be automatic- NOT require finger-counting. > Practice addition and subtraction WITH regrouping so you don't forget it! > KNOW your multiplication facts through the 10's. ○ Practice your facts with flash cards. ○ Use your Summer Journal to write lists of the fact families. ○ Play multiplication "WAR" with playing cards.
Religion	 ★ Attend Mass with your family when you can. ★ Even when you are on vacation, remember God is with you. Keep strong in your faith by praying and doing your best to help your parents and serve others. ★ Use your Summer Journal to write your thoughts, feelings, and questions about your faith.
