Reading	<p>★ Read at least 20 minutes each day.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Read <u>The One and Only Ivan</u> book I gave you and bring it to school in August! 2) Read one more book from the BOB list if possible: https://www.sjsathens.org/academics/battleofbooks.cfm 3) Read one other book of your choice if you have time! 4) Write about each book you read in the Writing Journal I gave you.

Math	<p>★ Practice your BASIC FACTS every week.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Addition and subtraction facts should be automatic and NOT require finger-counting in 4th grade. ➤ Practice addition and subtraction WITH regrouping so you don't forget it! ➤ KNOW your multiplication facts through the 10's. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Continue to use your SplashLearn account from 3rd grade. ○ Use the flash cards I made for you, and practice your facts often! ○ Play multiplication “WAR” with playing cards, racing a family member or friend to multiply the number each of you puts down!
Religion	<p>★ Attend Mass with your family when you can.</p> <p>★ Even when you are on vacation, remember God is with you. Keep strong in your faith by praying and doing your best to help your parents and serve others.</p>
